| The American Academy of Arts and Sciences Visiting Scholars Program | See website | This program provides residential fellowships for junior faculty members and postdoctoral scholars in the humanities and social sciences. The Academy seeks proposals in the humanities and social sciences relating to American history, culture, and public policy from the founding period to the present. |
| American Council of Learned Societies Fellowships | September 28, 2016 | Fellowships support research in all disciplines of the humanities and humanities-related social sciences. The project goal should be a major piece of scholarly (not creative) work by the applicant. Awards provide up to \$35,000 for assistant professor-level investigators for six to twelve months of research. |
| National Endowment for the Arts Creative Writing Fellowships and Translation Projects | March 9 and December 6, respectively | Fellowships in fiction, poetry, and creative nonfiction enable recipients to set aside time for writing, research, travel, and general career advancement. Non-matching grants are for \$25,000. Translation Projects enable recipients to translate work from other languages into English. Non-matching grants are for \$12,500 or \$25,000, depending upon the artistic excellence and merit of the project. |
| National Endowment for the Humanities Fellowships | April 26, 2017 | Fellowships support individuals pursuing advanced research that is of value to scholars and/or general audiences of the humanities. Fellowships cover periods lasting from six to twelve months at a stipend of \$4,200 per month. The maximum stipend is \$50,400 for a twelve-month period. |
| National Endowment for the Humanities Summer Stipends | September 29, 2016 | Summer stipends support individuals pursuing advanced research that is of value to scholars and/or general audiences of the humanities. Summer Stipends support continuous full-time work on a humanities project for a period of two consecutive months. |

| Stanford Humanities Center External Faculty Fellowships | October 5, 2016 | Junior fellowships are available for scholars who received their Ph.D. between three and ten years ago for research in the humanities. Stipends are up to \$70,000; housing allowance of up to \$30,000. |
| The Vilcek Foundation The Vilcek Prizes for Creative Promise | June | This \$50,000 prize recognizes talented, foreign-born artists living in the United States who have demonstrated significant creativity and originality in the early stages of their careers. Artists practicing in a variety of media such as painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, sculpture and other visual arts processes are eligible. |
